## Launching at the Challenger Learning Center of San Antonio

Our popular “Rendezvous with a Comet” mission is now available to the public on selected Saturdays.

 You are invited to participate in an exciting space-based learning environment that features Mission Control and Space Station Simulators. Team members in both simulators must work together to assemble and launch a probe into the tail of Comet Tempel 1.

 Along the way, team members will also encounter many important tasks that need to be performed in order to support the success of this important mission. This mission is perfect for children in grades 5 and up [*children in grades 3 & 4 MUST fly with a ticketed adult*].

### **Missions Launch Dates through 2008:**

**October 4, 2008 10:00 a.m. – Noon & November 1, 2008 10:00 a.m. – Noon**

**NOTE:** For the duration of the mission, participants will follow checklist instructions at a 6<sup>th</sup> grade reading level. Participants at the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> grade level **must** fly with a ticketed adult. This mission is not suitable for children in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade or lower.
